LEAVING THE WILDERNESS *Behind*



SCRIPTURE

*“Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.
See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not
perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and
streams in the wasteland.” — Isaiah 43:18–19*



SPIRITUAL APPLICATION: Scarcity often keeps us trapped in past financial mistakes, failures, or generational lack. Day 1 is about acknowledging that your current “wasteland” is temporary. Fasting acts as the physical mechanism to declare that you are no longer feeding the old cycle of limitation.



DEVOTIONAL

Many people carry the weight of yesterday's failures—financial mistakes, missed opportunities, disappointments, and even generations of poverty or lack. Those experiences can quietly convince us that tomorrow will simply look like yesterday.

But God speaks a different word.

He tells His people not to remain imprisoned by what has already happened. The same God who made streams appear in the desert is still able to make a way where none seems possible.

Biblically, fasting is not about manipulating God into blessing us. Rather, it is a declaration that our dependence is upon Him alone. As we willingly deny our physical appetites, we remind our hearts that our true source is not our paycheck, our investments, or our abilities—it is the Lord Himself.

Today, release every disappointment you've been carrying. Lay down fear. Lay down regret. Lay down every belief that says your future must be limited by your past.

God specializes in making new things grow in barren places.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- What past financial or personal failure am I still carrying?
- Have I allowed disappointment to define my expectations?
- Where is God inviting me to trust Him for something new?



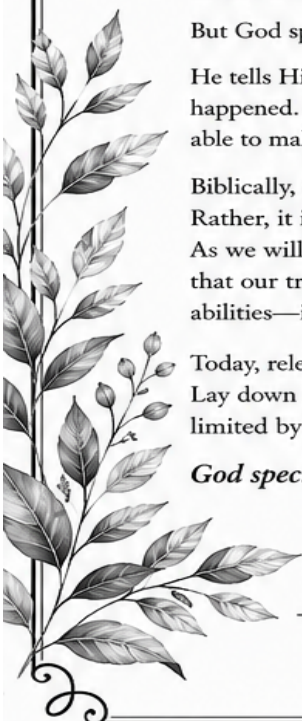
PRAYER

SCRIPTURE

“Remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today.”

— Deuteronomy 8:18



SPIRITUAL APPLICATION

It is no coincidence that this foundational verse is found in Deuteronomy 8. True personal power in talent, drive, and capacity to generate abundance come from a divine source. Use this day to step into your God-given authority, trading feelings of unworthiness for confidence and stewardship.



DEVOTIONAL

Success can tempt us toward pride, while failure often pulls us toward insecurity. God’s Word corrects both extremes.

Everything we possess—our gifts, wisdom, opportunities, creativity, strength, and ability to work—is ultimately a gift from Him.

Notice that Scripture says God gives us the ability to produce wealth. He often works through diligence, wisdom, integrity, faithful stewardship, and doors that only He can open.

When we remember the true source of every blessing, we no longer have to strive to prove ourselves. Confidence becomes rooted, not in our own strength, but in God’s faithfulness.

Today, exchange feelings of inadequacy for gratitude. Instead of asking, “Am I enough?” ask, “How can I faithfully steward what God has already placed in my hands?”

The Lord delights in multiplying what is surrendered to Him.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- Do I truly recognize God as the source of every good gift?
- Am I faithfully stewarding the opportunities He has already given me?
- Where have I relied more on my own strength than on His guidance?

Keep me humble when I succeed and hopeful when I struggle.
Teach me to steward wisely what You place in my hands.
